## ONE WAY YOU CAN SUPPORT YOUR STUDENT IN THE CLASSROOM IS HOLDING THEM ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR BEHAVIOR. HERE ARE SOME WAYS YOU CAN DO THAT:

**PBIS Color System**: Their color will be marked daily in their agenda – please sign and return their agenda. Blue = "I had a great day" Green = "I met the classroom expectations." Yellow = "I had trouble following the rules or meeting expecations." Red= "Something serious happened at school today"

**Class Dojo:** Connect on class dojo to get a picture of your student's day. This is also a great way to see what we're up to and receive communication.

**Attendance:** When your child is at school AND on time they are more likely to be engaged in learning and to understand what is going on. Having good attendance is just one of the qualifications for school-wide PBIS celebrations and celebratory trips. So even if your child is on blue every day, they may still miss out.
