
GRADING UPDATES

Step 1: Go to www.google.com.


Click on the blue Sign In button in the upper right hand corner.


Step 2: You will be taken to the Google sign in screen. Enter your City Schools' username (Student ID Number@bcpss.org).




Step 4: Click on the Waffle icon next to your child's initial to access the Google Suite. Click on the Google Classroom icon.
