



# When Words Are Tricky, Roll Up Your Sleeves!


Check the picture and think, "What would make sense?"

Look through the WHOLE word, part-by-part.




Look for a word inside a word.




Don't give up! Try something! Take a guess!




Reread and ask, "Does that sound right?"
